(II) <u>A holder of a Class A beer, wine and liquor license or any agent.</u>

5 (c) <u>Notwithstanding any other provisions of this article, if a Class B on-sale</u>

6 licensee has live entertainment within the licensed premises on Friday, or Saturday

7 nights, the licensee may sell or serve alcoholic beverages FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE

8 LICENSED PREMISES, in accordance with his license, between the hours of 6:00 a.m.

9 and 3:00 a.m. of the following day.

10 (e) The holder of a Class A (off-sale) license who offers for sale in his licensed

11 premises commodities other than alcoholic beverages and is open on Sundays for the

12 sale of such commodities shall keep all alcoholic beverages upon the premises in a

13 separate beverage department securely closed and locked in a compartment,

14 compartments or enclosure between the hours of [2:00 a.m.] 12:00 A.M. on Sunday

15 <u>and 6:00 a.m. the following Monday, subject to regulations of the Board of License</u>
16 Commissioners not inconsistent with the provisions hereof. The provisions of this

17 subsection do not apply to alcoholic beverages in storage areas which are not open to

18 the public.

19 (f) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this article, but in addition thereto

20 the holder of a beer, wine and liquor license, Class B, his agents, servants or employees

21 may not sell any alcoholic beverages for consumption off the licensed premises between

22 the hours of [2:00 a.m.] 12:00 A.M. and 6:00 a.m. or on Sunday after [2:00 a.m.] 12:00

23 A.M. from any separate store established on the licensed premises as an "off-sale store"

24 or to keep an "off-sale store" open for business on Sunday after [2 a.m.] 12:00 A.M.

25 except that beer and light wine only may be sold from an "off-sale" store which is

26 attached to and a part of the licensed premises on Sunday after [eight a.m.] 8:00 A.M.

27 <u>until [two a.m.] 12:00 A.M. the day following. For the purpose of this provision, the</u>

28 <u>Board of License Commissioners shall determine by reasonable standards what shall</u> 29 constitute an "off-sale store". Nothing further herein shall be construed to permit sales
