- 1 (i) In Washington County, this section does not apply to:
- 2 (1) The Washington County Playhouse; or
- 3 (2) A theater holding a Class B beer, wine and liquor on-sale license 4 under  $\S$  6-201(w) of this article.
- 5 (j) (1) This subsection applies only in Caroline County.
- 6 (2) After a finding that the activities enumerated in this section have 7 occurred, the Board of License Commissioners may decide whether or not to revoke a 8 license, notwithstanding the mandatory provisions of subsection (b) of this section.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Prince George's
- 10 County Board of License Commissioners of Prince George's County shall exempt from
- 11 this Act any current alcoholic beverages license holder that currently conducts an
- 12 activity that is made unlawful by this Act. The exemption under this section does not
- 13 apply to current license holders that did not receive approval from the Prince
- 14 George's County Board of License Commissioners to conduct activities made unlawful
- 15 by this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 17 October 1, 2005.
