- 24 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO STATE BUILDINGS IN WHICH MORE THAN
- 25 50 STATE EMPLOYEES ARE EMPLOYED.
- 26 (B) THERE IS A STATE BUILDING SMART GROWTH PROGRAM.

- 1 (C) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND
- 2 SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, ANY NEW STATE BUILDING THAT IS PLANNED FOR

- 7 GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL BE LOCATED NOT LESS THAN ONE-QUARTER MILE FROM
- 8 A LIGHT RAIL STOP, A METRO STOP, OR A RAILROAD STATION.
- 9 (D) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS MAY EXEMPT A STATE BUILDING FROM 10 THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
