1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County - Salary Study Commission - Composition**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the composition of the Salary Study Commission for
4 Washington County; and generally relating to the composition of the Salary

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions**

19 12-203.

20 (a) (1) The Commission consists of nine members.

21 (2) Each member shall be a registered voter of Washington County who
22 in the previous 4 years has voted in at least two elections, at least one of which shall
23 have been in the gubernatorial election year.

24 (b) The Commission shall be comprised as follows:

25 (1) One member from the Democratic Party Central Committee of
26 Washington County;

1 (2) One member from the Republican Party Central Committee of
2 Washington County;

3 (3) One member from the Washington County Chamber of Commerce;

4 (4) One member from the Washington County Farm Bureau;

5 (5) One member from the League of Women Voters of Washington
6 County;

7 (6) One member from the Western Maryland Central Labor Council;

8 (7) [One member from the Washington County Taxpayers Association;
9 and

10 (8) Two members] ONE MEMBER FROM THE CUMBERLAND VALLEY
11 ASSOCIATED BUILDERS AND CONTRACTORS, INC.;

12 (8) ONE MEMBER FROM THE JOINT VETERANS COUNCIL OF
13 WASHINGTON COUNTY; AND

14 (9) ONE MEMBER at large selected by the Executive Committee of the
15 Washington County Council of PTA's. The president of the Council may be [one of
16 these members] THE MEMBER SELECTED.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2005.
