3 FOR the purpose of requiring the St. Mary's County Compensation Review
4 Commission periodically to review and make recommendations about the
5 salaries and benefits for the members of the St. Mary's County Board of
6 Education; and generally relating to the authority of the St. Mary's County
7 Compensation Review Commission.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 19 - St. Mary's County**

16 23-5.

17 By December 1, 2000, and by December 1 every fourth year thereafter, the
18 Commission shall:

19 (1) Review the salaries set by law for:

20 (I) St. Mary's County officials; AND

1 (II) MEMBERS OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION;

2 (2) Review State and local laws and the procedures followed in St. Mary's
3 County concerning the inclusion of benefits as part of the compensation of [the]:

4 (I) County Commissioners; AND

5 (II) MEMBERS OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION;

6 (3) Make recommendations to the County Commissioners concerning the
7 compensation set by law for [county]:

8 (I) COUNTY officials; and

9 (II) MEMBERS OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION;

10 AND

11 (4) Make a special recommendation concerning the inclusion of benefits
12 as part of the compensation of:

13 (I) County Commissioners; AND

14 (II) MEMBERS OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2005.
