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2 Baltimore County - People's Counsel

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the County Executive of Baltimore County to appoint a
- 4 People's Counsel; creating an Office of People's Counsel; specifying the term of
- office, qualifications, salary, powers, duties, and purposes of the People's

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions

- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE BALTIMORE COUNTY
- 20 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT,
- 21 PERMITS OFFICE.
- 22 (B) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF BALTIMORE COUNTY SHALL APPOINT A
- 23 PEOPLE'S COUNSEL WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF
- 24 BALTIMORE COUNTY.
- 25 (C) (1) THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL IS 3 YEARS.
- 26 (2) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE MAY REMOVE THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL FOR
- 27 INCOMPETENCE, MISCONDUCT, OR OTHER GOOD CAUSE.

- 1 (D) THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL:
- 2 (1) SHALL HAVE BEEN ADMITTED TO PRACTICE LAW IN THE STATE; AND
- 3 (2) SHALL HAVE KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERTISE IN MATTERS 4 PERTAINING TO STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT LAW AND ADMINISTRATIVE LAW.
- 5 (E) BEFORE TAKING OFFICE, THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL SHALL TAKE THE OATH 6 REQUIRED BY ARTICLE I, § 9 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.
- 7 (F) THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL:
- 8 (1) SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME TO THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE; AND
- 9 (2) IS ENTITLED TO A SALARY AS PROVIDED IN THE BALTIMORE COUNTY 10 BUDGET.
- 11 (G) (1) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BUDGET SHALL PROVIDE SUFFICIENT
- 12 MONEY FOR THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL TO HIRE NECESSARY STAFF AND TO
- 13 ADMINISTER AND MAINTAIN AN OFFICE.
- 14 (2) THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL MAY RETAIN AS NECESSARY FOR A
- 15 PARTICULAR MATTER OR HIRE EXPERTS, INCLUDING ACCOUNTANTS, CONSULTANTS,
- 16 AND LAWYERS.
- 17 (H) (1) WITH REGARD TO ANY MATTER FOR WHICH THE STATE HAS
- 18 DELEGATED ITS AUTHORITY TO THE DEPARTMENT THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL SHALL
- 19 REVIEW, INVESTIGATE, MAKE FINDINGS, AND RESPOND TO A COMPLAINT FILED BY
- 20 ANY PERSON WITH REGARD TO THE DEPARTMENT'S ACTION ON A PERMIT OR
- 21 LICENSE.
- 22 (2) WITH REGARD TO ANY MATTER THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF A
- 23 COMPLAINT UNDER THIS SECTION, THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL SHALL HAVE FULL
- 24 ACCESS TO THE RECORDS OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- 25 (3) THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL SHALL HAVE AS ITS PRIMARY PURPOSES:
- 26 (I) TO RESOLVE QUICKLY ANY DISPUTE BETWEEN AN APPLICANT
- 27 AND THE DEPARTMENT INVOLVING A PERMIT;
- 28 (II) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, TO HELP AFFECTED PARTIES
- 29 AVOID UNNECESSARY LITIGATION; AND
- 30 (III) TO ENSURE THAT APPLICANTS AND THE DEPARTMENT ENGAGE
- 31 IN RESPECTFUL AND FAIR DEALING.
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 33 October 1, 2005.
