- 3 FOR the purpose of providing for the registration of certain off-the-road vehicles;
- 4 prohibiting the operation of an off-the-road vehicle on a public sidewalk, on a
- 5 controlled access highway, or on a highway except under certain circumstances;
- 6 prohibiting the operation of an unregistered off-the-road vehicle; prohibiting
- 7 the operation of an off-the-road vehicle during certain hours; prohibiting the
- 8 operation of an off-the-road vehicle by a person under a certain age except
- 9 under certain circumstances; requiring a person operating or riding as a
- passenger on an off-the-road vehicle to wear certain protective headgear;
- providing for the issuance of citations to violators of provisions of this Act;
