20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 (A) (1) 26 INDICATED.	IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS

4 (1) A PREFERRED LIST OF COVERED PRESCRIPTION DRUGS;

5 (2) REBATES FROM DRUG MANUFACTURERS; AND

6 (3) NEGOTIATED DISCOUNTS.

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7 (C) THE MARYLAND RX PROGRAM SHALL:

8 (1) BE THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFIT PLAN FOR ENROLLEES OF 9 THE STATE EMPLOYEE AND RETIREE HEALTH AND WELFARE BENEFITS PROGRAM; 10 AND

11(2)OFFER PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFITS TO ANY PERSON THAT12SATISFIES THE CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

13 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP THE PREFERRED LIST OF COVERED 14 PRESCRIPTION DRUGS USING AN EVIDENCE-BASED ANALYSIS THAT:

15 (1) FIRST IDENTIFIES THE RELATIVE EFFECTIVENESS OF
16 PRESCRIPTION DRUGS WITHIN THERAPEUTIC CLASSES FOR PARTICULAR DISEASES
17 AND CONDITIONS; AND

18 (2) NEXT IDENTIFIES THE LEAST COSTLY PRESCRIPTION DRUGS,
 19 INCLUDING GENERIC DRUGS, AMONG THE DRUGS FOUND TO BE EQUALLY
 20 EFFECTIVE.

(E) (1) EXCEPT FOR THE STATE EMPLOYEE AND RETIREE HEALTH AND
WELFARE BENEFITS PROGRAM, EACH PERSON PARTICIPATING IN THE MARYLAND RX
PROGRAM SHALL BEAR THE COST OF DRUGS PURCHASED THROUGH THE PROGRAM.

24(2)NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE25STATE MAY PROVIDE START-UP FUNDS FOR THE MARYLAND RX PROGRAM.

26 (F) THE DEPARTMENT MAY:

27 (1) CHARGE AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE SUFFICIENT TO OFFSET ITS
28 COSTS TO PERSONS THAT PARTICIPATE IN THE MARYLAND RX PROGRAM; AND

29 (2) CONTRACT WITH A PHARMACY BENEFIT MANAGER OR OTHER
 30 ENTITY TO ADMINISTER THE MARYLAND RX PROGRAM.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect32 October 1, 2005.
