13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - State Personnel and Pensions

16 8-202.

17 (a) An employee of the State Fire Marshal's Office is entitled to extra pay,

18 known as hazardous duty pay, if the employee works as a member of a bomb squad or 19 as an explosives technician.

20 (b) Hazardous duty pay under this section shall be set by the Secretary in an 21 amount not to exceed [\$50] \$150 a month.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 23 effect July 1, 2005.
