2 **Office of the State Fire Marshal - Hazardous Duty Pay**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum amount of monthly hazardous duty pay
 4 that the Secretary of Budget and Management is required to set for certain
 5 employees of the State Fire Marshal's office; and generally relating to the
 6 authority of the Secretary to increase special pay provisions for certain members
 7 of the Office of the State Fire Marshal.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

16 8-202.

17 (a) An employee of the State Fire Marshal's Office is entitled to extra pay,
 18 known as hazardous duty pay, if the employee works as a member of a bomb squad or
 19 as an explosives technician.

20 (b) Hazardous duty pay under this section shall be set by the Secretary in an
 21 amount not to exceed [\$50] \$150 a month.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect July 1, 2005.
