### A BILL ENTITLED

# 7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF8 MARYLAND, That:

9 (1) In accordance with Title 19 of the Education Article of the Annotated Code 10 of Maryland (2004 Replacement Volume and 2004 Supplement), each of the following 11 projects is approved as a project for an academic facility, and the University System of 12 Maryland may issue, sell, and deliver bonds in the total principal amount of 13 \$13,125,000 for the purposes of financing and refinancing the costs of these projects:

nor do the bonds constitute a debt or obligation contracted by the General Assembly of
 Maryland or pledge the faith and credit of the State within the meaning of Article III,
 Section 34 of the Maryland of Constitution.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 June 1, 2005.
