1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article - Transportation** 4 13-619.3. IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 5 (A) (1) 6 INDICATED. "FOUNDATION" MEANS THE AFRICAN-AMERICAN MUSEUM 8 FOUNDATION, INC., A NONPROFIT FOUNDATION OF THE REGINALD F. LEWIS 9 MUSEUM OF MARYLAND AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY AND CULTURE. 10 "MUSEUM" MEANS THE REGINALD F.
