 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (c) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the rentals, rates, 21 fees, tolls, and other charges and revenues are not subject to supervision or regulation 22 by any instrumentality, agency, or unit of this State or any of its political subdivisions.	
23 (2) This subtitle does not permit the exercise of any power or the 24 undertaking of any activity that would conflict with the provisions and limitations of 25 the federal Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964.	
 26 (3) Tolls for the use of the bridge carrying the John F. Kennedy Memorial 27 Highway over the Susquehanna River may not be less than the comparable tolls 28 charged for the use of the Susquehanna River Bridge.

1 (4) Prior to fixing or revising tolls on any part of any transportation

2 facilities project, the Authority shall provide, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State

5 Committee information on the proposed toll charges, including:

9 (5) (I) THE AUTHORITY SHALL TEMPORARILY STOP COLLECTING 10 TOLLS FOR THE WILLIAM PRESTON LANE, JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE (CHESAPEAKE BAY 11 BRIDGE) IF THE AUTHORITY DETERMINES THAT VEHICULAR TRAFFIC APPROACHING 12 THE BRIDGE IS SO CONGESTED THAT EASTBOUND VEHICLES ARE WAITING 30 13 MINUTES OR LONGER TO CROSS THE BRIDGE.

(II) IF THE AUTHORITY STOPS COLLECTING TOLLS UNDER
SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE AUTHORITY SHALL RESUME
COLLECTING TOLLS WHEN THE AUTHORITY DETERMINES THAT THE TRAFFIC
CONDITIONS DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH ARE NO
LONGER PRESENT.

(III) IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF
 SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE AUTHORITY SHALL TAKE WHATEVER
 ACTION MAY BE NECESSARY TO OBTAIN A MODIFICATION OF ANY TRUST
 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE AUTHORITY AND A CORPORATE TRUSTEE THAT
 SECURES REVENUE BONDS FOR THE BRIDGE.
