18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 The provisions of §§ 14-301 through 14-305 of this subtitle, and any regulations
23 adopted under those sections, shall be of no effect and may not be enforced after [July
24 1, 2006] JULY 1, 2012.

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
3 October 1, 2004. It shall remain effective for a period of [3] 7 years AND 9 MONTHS
4 and, at the end of [September 30, 2007] JUNE 30, 2012, with no further action
5 required by the General Assembly, this Act, and any regulations adopted under the
6 provisions of this Act, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
