## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County - Education - Organization of Teachers and Other Personnel**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of a "public school employee" in Carroll  
4 County, as it relates to the organization of certificated employees, to include a  
5 supervisory noncertificated employee; and generally relating to the organization  
6 of teachers and other personnel in Carroll County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article - Education  
9 Section 6-401(d)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2004 Replacement Volume and 2004 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 6-401.

16 (d) (1) "Public school employee" means a certificated professional individual  
17 who is employed by a public school employer or an individual of equivalent status in  
18 Baltimore City, except for a county superintendent or an individual designated by the  
19 public school employer to act in a negotiating capacity as provided in § 6-408(b) of  
20 this subtitle.

21 (2) In Montgomery County, "public school employees" include:

22 (i) Certificated and noncertificated substitute teachers employed  
23 by the public school employer for at least 7 days before March 1 of the school fiscal  
24 year ending June 30, 1978, and each year after; and

25 (ii) Home and hospital teachers employed by the public school  
26 employer for at least 7 days before March 1 of the school fiscal year ending June 30,  
27 2000, and each year after.

1 (3) In Baltimore County, "public school employee" includes:

2 (i) A secondary school nurse, an elementary school nurse, and a  
3 special school nurse; and

4 (ii) Supervisory noncertificated employees as defined under §  
5 6-501(h) of this title.

6 (4) In Frederick County, "public school employee" includes a social  
7 worker employed by a public school employer.

8 (5) In Prince George's County, "public school employee" includes home  
9 and hospital teachers and junior reserve officer training (JROTC) instructors.

10 (6) IN CARROLL COUNTY, "PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE" INCLUDES  
11 SUPERVISORY NONCERTIFICATED EMPLOYEES AS DEFINED UNDER § 6-501(H) OF  
12 THIS TITLE.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
14 October 1, 2005.
