1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County - Education - Organization of Teachers and Other Personnel**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of a "public school employee" in Carroll
4 County, as it relates to the organization of certificated employees, to include a
5 supervisory noncertificated employee; and generally relating to the organization
6 of teachers and other personnel in Carroll County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 6-401.

16 (d) (1) "Public school employee" means a certificated professional individual
17 who is employed by a public school employer or an individual of equivalent status in
18 Baltimore City, except for a county superintendent or an individual designated by the
19 public school employer to act in a negotiating capacity as provided in § 6-408(b) of
20 this subtitle.

21 (2) In Montgomery County, "public school employees" include:

1 (i) Certificated and noncertificated substitute teachers employed
2 by the public school employer for at least 7 days before March 1 of the school fiscal
3 year ending June 30, 1978, and each year after; and

4 (ii) Home and hospital teachers employed by the public school
5 employer for at least 7 days before March 1 of the school fiscal year ending June 30,
6 2000, and each year after.

7 (3) In Baltimore County, "public school employee" includes:

8 (i) A secondary school nurse, an elementary school nurse, and a
9 special school nurse; and

10 (ii) Supervisory noncertificated employees as defined under §
11 6-501(h) of this title.

12 (4) In Frederick County, "public school employee" includes a social
13 worker employed by a public school employer.

14 (5) In Prince George's County, "public school employee" includes home
15 and hospital teachers and junior reserve officer training (JROTC) instructors.

16 (6) IN CARROLL COUNTY, "PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE" INCLUDES
17 SUPERVISORY NONCERTIFICATED EMPLOYEES AS DEFINED UNDER § 6-501(H) OF
18 THIS TITLE.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2005.
