"Public school employee" means a certificated professional individual 16 (d) 17 who is employed by a public school employer or an individual of equivalent status in 18 Baltimore City, except for a county superintendent or an individual designated by the 19 public school employer to act in a negotiating capacity as provided in § 6-408(b) of 20 this subtitle.
