4 FOR the purpose of amending the Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 to
 5 remove a requirement that the Board of Directors of the Salisbury Wicomico
 6 Arts Council grant and convey a certain easement to the Maryland Historical
 7 Trust.

 9 Chapter 204 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2003, as amended by
 10 Chapter 432 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (ii) \$2,500,000 for the following projects initially approved by the House:

18 (T) Boulevard Theatre Performing Arts Complex. Provide a grant
 19 equal to the lesser of (i) \$175,000 or (ii) the amount of the
 20 matching fund provided, to the Board of Directors of the
 21 Salisbury Wicomico Arts Council, Inc. for the design,

1 construction, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping
 2 of the Boulevard Theatre, located in Salisbury[, subject to a
 3 requirement that the grantee grant and convey an historic
 4 easement to the Maryland Historical Trust]. Notwithstanding
 5 section 13(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of real
 6 property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the
 7 effective date of this Act (Wicomico County) 175,000

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 9 June 1, 2005.
