4 FOR the purpose of altering the nonrefundable fee that the Department of
5 Assessments and Taxation must collect to process a notice of change of the name
6 or address of a resident agent; establishing a certain maximum fee for a bulk
7 filing of notices of changes of the names or addresses of resident agents; and
8 generally relating to fees collected by the Department of Assessments and
9 Taxation.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (a) In addition to any organization and capitalization fee required under §
4 1-204 of this article, subject to subsection (c) of this section, the Department shall
5 collect the fees specified in subsection (b) of this section.

6 (b) (2) For each of the following documents, the nonrefundable processing
7 fee is [\$25] AS INDICATED:

8 (i) Notice of change of address of principal office[;] \$25

9 (ii) Notice of change of name or address of resident agent[;] \$25, UP
10 TO A MAXIMUM OF ~~\$10,000~~ \$20,000 FOR A BULK FILING

11 (iii) Certificate of correction[; and] \$25

12 (iv) Any other documents[.] \$25

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2005.
