- FOR the purpose of authorizing an insurer certain insurers to conduct a certain pilot

- before the end of the approved period of time; establishing procedures for the
- extension of a pilot program, the end of a pilot program and the withdrawal of
- rates and forms, and the conversion of a pilot program to a formal line of
- insurance;; requiring a policy of motor vehicle liability insurance issued under a

- AN APPROVED PILOT PROGRAM SHALL COMPLY WITH THE 1 2 PROVISIONS OF § 27-605(D) OF THIS ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 3
- 4 31 of each year, the Maryland Insurance Commissioner shall report to the Governor
- 5 and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General
- 6 Assembly on pilot programs approved under this Act. The report shall describe each
- 7 approved pilot program and indicate the time period in which it was or will be
- 8 conducted. In complying with this section, the Commissioner may include the
- 9 information in its annual report under § 2-110 of the Insurance Article.
