12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Regulation

16 (a) The Unit may deny registration to an applicant, reprimand a registrant,
17 suspend or revoke a registration, or impose a civil penalty on a registrant if the Unit
18 determines that the applicant or registrant:

(8) [repeatedly] violated a LOCAL, State, or federal law or regulation,
 INCLUDING AN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION LAW OR REGULATION, that relates to
 the fitness and qualification or ability of the applicant or registrant to build homes;

22 (10) [repeatedly] engaged in fraud, deception, misrepresentation, or 23 knowing omissions of material facts related to home building contracts;

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 July 1, 2005.
