21	(a) Pursuant to the provisions of § 5 of Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland prohibiting any municipal corporation classified by the General Assembly under the provisions of § 2 of Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland from levying any type of tax, license fee, franchise tax or fee which was not in effect in the
