A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Antique Motor Vehicles - Registration

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "historic motor vehicle" to include only

4 vehicles manufactured in a certain model year or later; defining the term

5 "antique motor vehicle"; providing for the registration of antique motor vehicles;

6 establishing a registration fee; providing that the registration of an antique

7 motor vehicle is not transferable; requiring an application for registration as an

8 antique motor vehicle to contain certain certifications; requiring the Motor

9 Vehicle Administration to issue a special registration plate for a vehicle

10 registered under this Act; exempting a vehicle registered as an antique motor

11 vehicle from certain provisions of law; authorizing a vehicle registered as an

12 antique motor vehicle to display vintage registration plates; making stylistic

13 changes; and generally relating to the registration of antique motor vehicles.

5 6 7 8 9	(h) (1) A vehicle registered as a historic [or antique vehicle] (Class L) VEHICLE OR AN ANTIQUE (CLASS R) VEHICLE in this State or in another state, when used or driven in this State, may display vintage registration plates as an indication of the historic or antique nature of the vehicle. Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the place on the vehicle provided for the display of registration plates may only be used for the display of current registration plates in accordance with subsections (a) through (c) of this section, and any vintage registration plates which are used shall be displayed elsewhere on the vehicle.
13 14	 (2) If the Administration authorizes the display of vintage registration plates in lieu of current registration plates, as provided in § 13-936.1 of this title, the vintage registration plates shall be displayed as required under subsections (a) through (c) of this section. However, the current registration plates shall be kept in the vehicle at all times.

	(a) In this section, "historic motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle, including a passenger vehicle, motorcycle, or truck, MANUFACTURED IN MODEL YEAR 1946 OR LATER AND that:
20	(1) Is AT LEAST 20 years old [or older];

3 (f) Except as provided in § 13-936.1 of this subtitle, on registration of a 4 vehicle under this section, the Administration shall issue a special, historic motor 5 vehicle registration plate of the size and design that the Administration determines.

6 (g) Unless the presence of the equipment was specifically required by a 7 statute of this State as a condition of sale when the vehicle was manufactured, the 8 presence of any specific equipment is not required for the operation of a vehicle 9 registered under this section.

10 (h) A vehicle registered under this section is exempt from any statute that 11 requires periodic vehicle inspections or that requires the use and inspection of 12 emission controls.

14 (a) In this section, "vintage registration plate" means a Maryland registration 15 plate that was actually issued for display on a motor vehicle in a year not less than 25 16 years prior to January 1 of each calendar year.

17 (b) (1) Subject to the provisions of this subsection, the owner of a motor 18 vehicle registered under § 13-936 [or], § 13-937.1, OR § 13-939.2 of this subtitle as a 19 Class L (historic) [or], Class N (street rod), OR CLASS R (ANTIQUE) vehicle may 20 display 2 vintage registration plates in lieu of current registration plates on that 21 vehicle.

22 (2) The Administration may authorize the display of 2 vintage 23 registration plates in lieu of current registration plates on a motor vehicle described 24 in paragraph (1) of this subsection if:

(i) The owner of the motor vehicle submits an application on a form

1 (2) A fee in addition to the onetime registration fee prescribed in 2 subsection (b)(2)(iii) of this section is not required for the issuance of the vintage 3 registration plates.

5 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "ANTIQUE MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR
6 VEHICLE, INCLUDING A PASSENGER VEHICLE, MOTORCYCLE, OR TRUCK,
7 MANUFACTURED IN A MODEL YEAR BEFORE 1946 AND THAT:

8 (I) HAS NOT BEEN SUBSTANTIALLY ALTERED FROM THE 9 MANUFACTURER'S ORIGINAL DESIGN; AND

10(II)MEETS CRITERIA CONTAINED IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY11THE ADMINISTRATION.

3 (F) UNLESS THE PRESENCE OF THE EQUIPMENT WAS SPECIFICALLY
4 REQUIRED BY A STATUTE OF THIS STATE AS A CONDITION OF SALE WHEN THE
5 VEHICLE WAS MANUFACTURED, THE PRESENCE OF ANY SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT IS
6 NOT REQUIRED FOR THE OPERATION OF A VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS
7 SECTION.

8 (G) A VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION IS EXEMPT FROM ANY
9 STATUTE THAT REQUIRES PERIODIC VEHICLE INSPECTIONS OR THAT REQUIRES THE
10 USE AND INSPECTION OF EMISSION CONTROLS.
