1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article - Transportation** 4 13-411. A vehicle registered as a historic [or antique vehicle] (Class L) 5 (h) (1) 6 VEHICLE OR AN ANTIQUE (CLASS R) VEHICLE in this State or in another state, when 7 used or driven in this State, may display vintage registration plates as an indication 8 of the historic or antique nature of the vehicle. Except as provided in paragraph (2) of 9 this subsection, the place on the vehicle provided for the display of registration plates 10 may only be used for the display of current registration plates in accordance with 11 subsections (a) through (c) of this section, and any vintage registration plates which 12 are used shall be displayed elsewhere on the vehicle. 13 (2) If the Administration authorizes the display of vintage registration 14 plates in lieu of current registration plates, as provided in § 13-936.1 of this title, the 15 vintage registration plates shall be displayed as required under subsections (a) 16 through (c) of this section. However, the current registration plates shall be kept in 17 the vehicle at all times. 18 13-936. 19 (a) In this section, "historic motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle, including a 20 passenger vehicle, motorcycle, or truck, MANUFACTURED IN MODEL YEAR 1946 OR 21 LATER AND that: 22 (1) Is AT LEAST 20 years old [or older]; 23 Has not been substantially altered from the manufacturer's original (2) 24 design; and 25 Meets criteria contained in [rules and] regulations [issued] (3) 26 ADOPTED by the Administration. 27 (b) In this section, "historic motor vehicle" does not include a vehicle that has 28 been remanufactured or reconstructed as a replica of an original vehicle. 29 If registered with the Administration under this section, every historic 30 motor vehicle is a Class L (historic) vehicle. 31 (d) For each Class L (historic) vehicle, the annual registration fee is \$25.50. 32 In applying for registration of a historic motor vehicle under this section, 33 the owner of the vehicle shall submit with the application a certification that the vehicle for which the application is made: 35 Will be maintained for use in exhibitions, club activities, parades, (1)
