13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "AMBER ALERT" MEANS THE MARYLAND CHILD AMBER
18 ALERT PLAN BY WHICH THE STATE POLICE ALERT THE BROADCAST MEDIA AND
19 STATE DEPARTMENTS THAT:

20 (1) A CHILD HAS BEEN ABDUCTED AND IS IN SERIOUS DANGER OF 21 BODILY HARM OR DEATH;

22 (2) DESCRIPTIVE INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE ABOUT THE CHILD AND 23 ALLEGED ABDUCTOR; AND

24 (3) THE CHILD AND ALLEGED ABDUCTOR ARE SUSPECTED OF BEING IN 25 THE BROADCAST AREA.

(B) A PERSON MAY NOT MAKE, OR CAUSE TO BE MADE, A STATEMENT,
 REPORT, OR COMPLAINT THAT THE PERSON KNOWS TO BE FALSE AS A WHOLE OR IN
 MATERIAL PART, TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE STATE, OF A COUNTY,
 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE, OR OF
 THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING POLICE WITH THE
 INTENT TO DECEIVE AND TO CAUSE AN AMBER ALERT TO BE ACTIVATED AS A
 RESULT OF THE STATEMENT, REPORT, OR COMPLAINT.

8 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
9 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR A
10 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$2,000 OR BOTH.
