BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, 8 Article - State Personnel and Pensions 9 10 Section 9-1107 11 Annotated Code of Maryland (2004 Replacement Volume) 12 13 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Chapter 389 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2003, as amended by 14 Chapter 122 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004 15 16 Section 2 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 19 20 9-1107. 21 This section applies to all employees, except temporary employees, of all (a) 22 units in the Executive, Judicial, and Legislative branches of State government, 23 including any unit with an independent personnel system. 24 (b) Military administrative leave may be provided to an employee subject to 25 this section who: 26 (1)is on active military duty on July 1, 2003; or

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(2) is activated for military duty on or after July 1, 2003.

2 (c) (1) An employee who is eligible to receive military administrative leave
3 under this section is entitled to leave in an amount sufficient to compensate the
4 employee, during each pay period for which the employee is eligible to receive military
5 administrative leave under this section, for the difference between the employee's
6 active duty base salary paid by the federal government and the employee's State base
7 salary or direct wages.

8 (2) Compensation provided under this subsection may not exceed an 9 employee's State base salary or direct wages.

10 (d) An employee eligible to receive military administrative leave under this 11 section who is activated for military duty on or after July 1, 2003, shall elect to use 12 either military administrative leave or paid leave as provided in § 9-1104(3) of this 13 subtitle.

14 (e) The Department shall keep a record of the use of military administrative 15 leave under this section.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect

19 July 1, 2003. It shall remain effective for a period of [2] 3 years and, at the end of

20 [June 30, 2005,] JUNE 30, 2006, with no further action required by the General

21 Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 June 1, 2005.
