12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16	(b) "Accidental personal injury" means:

- 17 (1) an accidental injury that arises:
- 18 (I) out of and in the course of employment; AND
- 19 (II) OUT OF UNUSUAL OR EXTRAORDINARY ACTIVITY;
- 20 an injury caused by a willful or negligent act of a third person
- 21 directed against a covered employee in the course of the employment of the covered
- 22 employee; or
- 23 (3) a disease or infection that naturally results from an accidental injury
- 24 that arises out of and in the course of employment, including:

1 (i) an occupational disease; and 2 (ii) frostbite or sunstroke caused by a weather condition.

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3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2005.
