13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article - Education

16 16-510.

(a) [Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section or otherwise by law, all
employees of the College are in the skilled service of the State Personnel Management
System.]

20 [(b)] All [officers, faculty, and administrative] employees of the College are in 21 an independent personnel system.

[(c)] (B) If [a] AN [skilled service] employee was employed by the State [in
accordance with subsection (a) of this section] IN THE SKILLED SERVICE OF THE
STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, beginning January 1, 1996, the
employee's years of service as an employee of Baltimore City shall be added to the
employee's years of service with the State for the purpose of determining:

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1 (1) The annual leave accrual rate provided in § 9-302 of the State 2 Personnel and Pensions Article;

3 (2) Seniority under Title 11, Subtitle 2 of the State Personnel and 4 Pensions Article, relating to layoffs; and

5 (3) Seniority under § 7-207(b) of the State Personnel and Pensions 6 Article, relating to promotions.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 8 effect July 1, 2005.
