A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education - Baltimore City Community College - Independent**
3 **Personnel System**

4 FOR the purpose of consolidating the personnel systems of Baltimore City
5 Community College by merging certain employees into the independent
6 personnel system; and generally relating to Baltimore City Community College
7 employees.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 16-510.

17 (a) [Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section or otherwise by law, all
18 employees of the College are in the skilled service of the State Personnel Management
19 System.]

20 [(b)] All [officers, faculty, and administrative] employees of the College are in
21 an independent personnel system.

22 [(c)] (B) If [a] AN [skilled service] employee was employed by the State [in
23 accordance with subsection (a) of this section] IN THE SKILLED SERVICE OF THE
24 STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, beginning January 1, 1996, the
25 employee's years of service as an employee of Baltimore City shall be added to the
26 employee's years of service with the State for the purpose of determining:

1 (1) The annual leave accrual rate provided in § 9-302 of the State
2 Personnel and Pensions Article;

3 (2) Seniority under Title 11, Subtitle 2 of the State Personnel and
4 Pensions Article, relating to layoffs; and

5 (3) Seniority under § 7-207(b) of the State Personnel and Pensions
6 Article, relating to promotions.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
8 effect July 1, 2005.
