4 FOR the purpose of clarifying that employees of the Maryland Automobile Insurance

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

County government to the extent that Montgomery County administers a State
program under Article 88A, § 13A(b) of the Code.

32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 33 effect June 1, 2005.

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
