16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Public Utility Companies**

19 5-302.

20 (a) [A] UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE COMMISSION, A public service
21 company shall file with the Commission:

22 (1) an annual report for the preceding calendar year; and

23 (2) special reports, information, contracts, records, and copies as
24 required by the Commission.

1 6-205.

2 (a) (1) This subsection does not apply to railroads.

3 (2) [Each] UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE COMMISSION, EACH
4 public service company shall file with the Commission an annual report containing
5 information on its corporate structure, affiliations of its officers and directors, and
6 debt holdings.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
8 effect October 1, 2005.
