2 **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses - Arts Center in**  
3 **Highlandtown**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain time requirement regarding the application by  
5 a certain arts center in a certain district of Baltimore City to convert a certain  
6 class of alcoholic beverages license into another class; and generally relating to  
7 alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore City.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

2 6-201.

3 (d) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Baltimore City.

4 (xi) Notwithstanding any restriction or requirement in this article  
5 regarding the issuance of Class B beer, wine and liquor licenses, a not for profit arts  
6 center in the Highlandtown arts and entertainment district that holds a Class C  
7 license on June 1, 2004, may apply to the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for  
8 Baltimore City to convert that license [on or before May 31, 2005,] into a Class B  
9 beer, wine and liquor license.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 June 1, 2005.
