4 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Baltimore City Republican Party
5 Central Committee; and generally relating to the membership of the Baltimore
6 City Republican Party Central Committee.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Election Law**

15 4-203.

16 (b) (1) In Baltimore City, the members of the Democratic Party Central
17 Committee shall be elected from the legislative districts of Baltimore City as follows:

18 (i) five members shall be elected from the Baltimore City part of
19 each of the eight legislative districts in which all or a majority of the population
20 resides in Baltimore City; and

21 (ii) one member shall be elected from the Baltimore City part of
22 each of the two legislative districts in which a minority of the population resides in
23 Baltimore City.

24 (2) (i) The members of the Republican Party Central Committee shall
25 be elected from each councilmanic district of Baltimore City.

26 (ii) [Four] TWO members shall be elected from each councilmanic
27 district.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2005.
