4 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Baltimore City Republican Party
 5 Central Committee; and generally relating to the membership of the Baltimore
 6 City Republican Party Central Committee.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Election Law**

15 4-203.

16 (b) (1) In Baltimore City, the members of the Democratic Party Central
 17 Committee shall be elected from the legislative districts of Baltimore City as follows:

18 (i) five members shall be elected from the Baltimore City part of
 19 each of the eight legislative districts in which all or a majority of the population
 20 resides in Baltimore City; and

1 (ii) one member shall be elected from the Baltimore City part of
2 each of the two legislative districts in which a minority of the population resides in
3 Baltimore City.

4 (2) (i) The members of the Republican Party Central Committee shall
5 be elected from each councilmanic district of Baltimore City.

6 (ii) [Four] TWO members shall be elected from each councilmanic
7 district.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2005.
