- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Chapter 546 of the Acts of 1996
- 16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 17 (b) It is the intent of the General Assembly that a portion of tuition be waived
- 18 only if:

- 1 (1) THE MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND NATIONAL GUARD REGISTERS FOR 2 AND ATTENDS A regularly scheduled course [space is available];
- 3 (2) the member of the Maryland National Guard is enrolled at the
- 4 institution; and
- 5 (3) the Maryland Adjutant General has certified that the member of the
- 6 Maryland National Guard has at least 24 months remaining to serve or has agreed in
- 7 writing to serve for a minimum of 24 months.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 9 effect July 1, 2005.
