16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Transportation**

19 16-106.

20 (a) Each application for a driver's license shall be made on the form that the
21 Administration requires.

22 (b) The application shall state:

23 (1) The full name, Maryland residence address, employer, race, sex,
24 height, weight, general physical condition, [and] date of birth, AND CITIZENSHIP of
25 the applicant;

1 (2) Whether the applicant previously has been refused a license to drive
2 and, if so:

3 (i) By what state or country; and

4 (ii) The date of and reason for the refusal;

5 (3) Whether the applicant previously has been licensed to drive and, if
6 so:

7 (i) When and by what state or country; and

8 (ii) Whether the license ever has been suspended, revoked, or
9 canceled and, if so, the date of and reason for the suspension, revocation, or
10 cancellation;

11 (4) Subject to the provisions of subsection (c) of this section, the
12 applicant's Social Security number; and

13 (5) Any other pertinent information that the Administration requires.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 2005.
