A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Judgeships - Circuit Courts and District Court**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of resident judges of the circuit court in
4 certain judicial circuits; altering the number of associate judges of the District
5 Court in certain districts; specifying the number of District Court judges to be
6 appointed from certain counties; and generally relating to judgeships in the
7 circuit courts and the District Court of Maryland.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

26 (3) District 3 -- 6, two to be appointed from Cecil County

27 (4) District 4 -- [4] 5, TWO TO BE APPOINTED FROM CALVERT COUNTY
28 AND two to be appointed from Charles County
