CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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Education - Physical Education Program - Standards Director

3 FOR the purpose of requiring public schools to have a physical education program, on

4 or before a certain date, that meets certain minimum standards; requiring the

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1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 (A) Each public school shall have a program of physical education that is given

- 6 in a planned and sequential manner to all students, kindergarten through grade 12,
- 7 to develop their good health and physical fitness and improve their motor

8 coordination and physical skills.

9 (B) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2010, EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL HAVE A

10 PROGRAM OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION THAT MEETS THE MINIMUM NATIONAL

11 STANDARDS FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION AS ESTABLISHED BY THE NATIONAL

12 ASSOCIATION FOR SPORT AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION.

13 (C) (1) (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL EMPLOY A FULL-TIME DIRECTOR OF 14 PHYSICAL EDUCATION.

15 (2) THE DIRECTOR SHALL ASSIST THE COUNTY BOARDS IN DEVELOPING

16 AND IMPLEMENTING LONG RANGE PLANS TO MEET THE MINIMUM NATIONAL

17 STANDARDS FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION AS ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF

18 THIS SECTION.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2005.
