13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 4	(a) (1) The Commission shall consist of $\frac{13}{15}$ members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
5 6	(2) (i) Of the 13 members, seven shall be individuals who do not have any connection with the management or policy of a health care provider or payor.
7 8	(ii) Of the remaining six members, only two shall be physicians and only two shall be payors, as defined in § 19-132 of this article.

26 27	(4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
28 29	(5) The Governor may remove a member for neglect of duty, incompetence, or misconduct.
30	(6) A member may not serve more than two consecutive terms.
