A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Common Sense Food Consumption Act**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from bringing a civil action against a seller
4 of food for damages or injunctive relief based on a claim of injury or death
5 resulting from the person's weight gain, obesity, or a health condition that is
6 related to weight gain or obesity; exempting certain actions from the
7 prohibition; defining a certain term; providing for the application of this Act;
8 and generally relating to civil actions against sellers of food.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

17 5-808.

18 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FOOD" MEANS:

19 (1) A SUBSTANCE THAT IS USED AS FOOD OR DRINK FOR HUMAN BEINGS
20 OR OTHER ANIMALS;

21 (2) A SUBSTANCE THAT IS USED AS A COMPONENT OF FOOD OR DRINK
22 FOR HUMAN BEINGS OR OTHER ANIMALS; OR

23 (3) CHEWING GUM.

24 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT BRING A CIVIL ACTION AGAINST A SELLER OF FOOD
25 FOR DAMAGES OR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF BASED ON A CLAIM OF INJURY OR DEATH

1 RESULTING FROM WEIGHT GAIN, OBESITY, OR A HEALTH CONDITION THAT IS
2 RELATED TO WEIGHT GAIN OR OBESITY.

3 (C) THIS SECTION DOES NOT INCLUDE AN ACTION:

4 (1) IN WHICH A SELLER KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY VIOLATED A
5 FEDERAL OR STATE LAW APPLICABLE TO THE MARKETING, DISTRIBUTION,
6 ADVERTISEMENT, LABELING, OR SALE OF THE FOOD, AND THE VIOLATION WAS A
7 PROXIMATE CAUSE OF THE INJURY OR DEATH RESULTING FROM WEIGHT GAIN,
8 OBESITY, OR A HEALTH CONDITION RELATED TO WEIGHT GAIN OR OBESITY;

9 (2) FOR BREACH OF CONTRACT OR EXPRESS WARRANTY IN
10 CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF FOOD; OR

11 (3) FOR THE SALE OF ADULTERATED FOOD.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
13 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
14 any effect on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of
15 this Act.

16 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2005.
