1 AN ACT concerning

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Health Occupations - Morticians - Licensing - Corporations

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Maryland State Board of Morticians to issue a

4 license to operate a mortuary science business and a funeral establishment

5 license to certain corporations; repealing certain restrictions on the issuance

6 and renewal of certain licenses; altering and establishing certain requirements

7 for the renewal of a license to operate a mortuary science business to a

8 corporation; requiring that certain information be included in an application

9 made by a corporation for the issuance or renewal of a license to operate a

10 mortuary science business; requiring an application for a funeral establishment

11 license submitted by a corporation to be signed by certain persons; requiring the

12 Board to issue a license to a funeral establishment that is owned or operated by

13 at least one licensed mortician or one licensed funeral director, or a holder of a

surviving spouse or corporation license; and generally relating to the issuance of

15 corporation licenses and funeral establishment licenses to corporations.

11 (3) Will be held responsible for any and all activities performed on the 12 premises.

13 (d) Signs and advertisements of a funeral establishment shall display the 14 name that appears on the establishment license.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2005.

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
