15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Criminal Procedure**

18 4-101.

19 (c) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, in addition to any other
20 law allowing a crime to be charged by citation, a police officer may issue a citation for:

1 (iv) misdemeanor theft under § 7-104(g)(2) OR (3) of the Criminal
2 Law Article.

3 (2) A police officer may issue a citation to a defendant if the officer is
4 satisfied with the defendant's evidence of identity and reasonably believes that the
5 defendant will comply with the citation.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2005.
