- 3 (B) THERE IS A GEOTHERMAL HEAT PUMP GRANT PROGRAM IN THE 4 ADMINISTRATION.
- 5 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO INDIVIDUALS 6 FOR A PORTION OF THE COST OF ACQUIRING AND INSTALLING A GEOTHERMAL HEAT 7 PUMP.
