- 7 award grants of not more than a certain amount under the Program; defining

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 20 INDICATED.

1 (2) "GEOTHERMAL HEAT PUMP" MEANS A HEATING AND COOLING 2 DEVICE THAT IS INSTALLED:

3 (I) USING GROUND LOOP TECHNOLOGY; AND

4 (II) ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2004, IN A NEW OR REMODELED 5 SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING.

6 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE GEOTHERMAL HEAT PUMP GRANT 7 PROGRAM.

8 (B) THERE IS A GEOTHERMAL HEAT PUMP GRANT PROGRAM IN THE 9 ADMINISTRATION.

10 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO INDIVIDUALS
11 FOR A PORTION OF THE COST OF ACQUIRING AND INSTALLING A GEOTHERMAL HEAT
12 PUMP.

13 (D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:

14 (1) ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM;

15 (2) ESTABLISH APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR THE PROGRAM; AND

16 (3) AWARD GRANTS FROM THE PROGRAM.

17 (E) A GRANT AWARDED UNDER THE PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED \$3,000 \$1,000
18 OR 20% OF THE INSTALLED COST OF THE GEOTHERMAL SYSTEM, WHICHEVER IS
19 LESS.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, for fiscal year 2006,

21 funding for the Geothermal Heat Pump Grant Program shall be as provided in the

22 State budget. It is the intent of the General Assembly that beginning in fiscal year

23 2007, at least \$500,000 shall be included in the State budget for the Geothermal Heat

24 Pump Grant Program.
