19 (a) A contractual employee who transfers to a budgeted position under this

20 subtitle or who is selected to fill a budgeted position in the State Personnel

21 Management System, without a break in service, in [the same] ANY principal unit

22 that employs the contractual employee, shall be given credit for service in the

23 contractual position for the purpose of establishing:

- 24 (1) steps in the pay grade applicable to the budgeted position;
- 25 (2) annual leave; and
- 26 (3) seniority rights.
