Consolidation of State Forest and Park Rangers and Natural Resources Police - Additional Training Prohibited

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Department of Natural Resources from requiring

- 5 additional training as a condition of transfer for certain employees in the
- 6 implementation of the consolidation of the State Forest and Park Service
- 7 Rangers and the Natural Resources Police; making this Act an emergency
- 8 measure; and generally relating to the training requirements in the
- 9 consolidation of the State Forest and Park Service Rangers and the Natural
- 10 Resources Police.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That in the consolidation of the Natural Resources Police and the State

13 Forest and Park Service Rangers, the Department of Natural Resources may not

14 require a sworn law enforcement employee classified in the State personnel system on

15 March 24, 2004, as a Ranger II, Park Services Specialist, Park Services Supervisor, or

16 Park Ranger Supervisor within the State Forest and Park Service to complete

17 additional training before being transferred to the Natural Resources Police.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an

19 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health

20 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the

21 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take

22 effect from the date it is enacted.
