4 FOR the purpose of exempting the Maryland Public Broadcasting Commission from
 5 the State procurement law for certain activities relating to grants and
 6 cooperative agreements that support the educational and cultural activities of
 7 the Commission; and generally relating to the exemption of the Maryland Public
 8 Broadcasting Commission from the State procurement law.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

18 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this Division II does
 19 not apply to:

20 (1) procurement by:

1 (vii) the Maryland Public Broadcasting Commission[,]:

2 1. for services of artists for educational and cultural
3 television productions; OR

4 2. WHEN PLANNING FOR OR FULFILLING THE OBLIGATIONS
5 OF GRANTS OR COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS THAT SUPPORT THE EDUCATIONAL AND
6 CULTURAL ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMISSION;

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2005.
