- WITHIN AN ENCLOSURE, TO TURN IN A COMPLETE CIRCLE (I) 7 WITHOUT TOUCHING ANY SIDE OF THE ENCLOSURE: OR
- WHEN TETHERED TO AN OBJECT, TO TURN IN A COMPLETE 8 (II)9 CIRCLE WITHOUT TOUCHING THE OBJECT.
- 10 THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE ACT OF KEEPING A SOW AND ITS 11 PIGLETS FOR A REASONABLE TIME IN WHAT IS COMMONLY CALLED A "FARROWING 12 CRATE".
