- 21 (A) (1) THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION FOUNDATION
- 22 AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING SHALL ESTABLISH A CRITICAL FARMS

- 24 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE INTERIM OR
