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## 2 Optional Retirement Program - Eligibility

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the eligibility provisions for the Optional Retirement
- 4 Program to include individuals in certain positions designated as exempt by the
- 5 Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland or the Board of Regents
- 6 of Morgan State University; providing that an individual who was a participant
- 7 in the Optional Retirement Program as of a certain date may continue to
- 8 participate in the Program under certain circumstances; providing for the
- 9 application of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally
- relating to eligibility for the Optional Retirement Program.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 18 Article - State Personnel and Pensions

- 19 30-301.
- 20 (A) An individual is eligible to participate in the program if the individual is
- 21 eligible for membership in a retirement system or a pension system and is:
- 22 (1) a member of the faculty of an employing institution;
- 23 (2) a professional employee at a community college or regional
- 24 community college established under Title 16 of the Education Article;
- 25 (3) an employee of the University System of Maryland who is [not in a
- 26 position designated to be treated in the same manner as a classified service employee
- 27 under § 12-111 of the Education Article] IN A POSITION DESIGNATED AS EXEMPT

- 1 UNDER A POLICY ADOPTED BY THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND BOARD OF 2 REGENTS:
- 3 (4) an employee of Morgan State University who is [not subject to the
- 4 provisions of Division I of the State Personnel and Pensions Article] IN A POSITION
- 5 DESIGNATED AS PROFESSIONAL OR ADMINISTRATIVE BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS
- 6 OF MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY; or
- 7 (5) an employee of St. Mary's College of Maryland who is in a position
- 8 determined by the Board of Trustees of the College to be a professional or faculty
- 9 position.
- 10 (B) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS A PARTICIPANT IN THE PROGRAM AS OF
- 11 AUGUST 22, 2004, WHO IS IN A POSITION THAT IS NO LONGER A POSITION ELIGIBLE
- 12 FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM UNDER THIS SECTION MAY CONTINUE TO
- 13 PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM IF THE INDIVIDUAL:
- 14 (1) WOULD OTHERWISE BE ELIGIBLE FOR MEMBERSHIP IN A SYSTEM
- 15 UNDER THE STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM; AND
- 16 (2) IS EMPLOYED BY AN EMPLOYING INSTITUTION.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 18 construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect any
- 19 individual who was a participant in the Optional Retirement Program as of August
- 20 22, 2004, who is in a position that as of August 23, 2004, is no longer a position
- 21 eligible for participation in the Optional Retirement Program under § 30-301 of the
- 22 State Personnel and Pensions Article.
- 23 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 24 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 25 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 26 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 27 the date it is enacted.
